- 130 Yalumba, **Viognier**, Eden Valley, Australia, 2007 *Wine Spectator 91 pts* 38
Traditional to France's Rhône Valley, Viognier is exotic with distinctive floral aromas and apricot and pear flavors. It is a medium weight with a lingering finish.
-  135 Peter Lehmann "**Layers**," Adelaide Hills, Australia, 2009 *Wine Spectator 87 pts* 29
Refreshing with rich, pure fruit without oak influence. The blend of grapes produces balanced complexity in an easy drinking package.

LIGHT-MEDIUM BODIED, SEMI-DRY WHITES




Aromatic, Versatile, Lightly Sweet

- 200 Chateau Ste. Michelle/Dr. Loosen, **Riesling** "Eroica," Columbia Valley, WA 2007 *Wine Spectator 91 pts* 44
Named after Beethoven's masterpiece, Eroica shows bracing acidity against lightly sweet, expressive pear, apricot and quince aromas and flavors.
- 205 Dr. Heyden, **Riesling** Oppenheimer Kabinett, Rheinhessen, Germany, 2008 30
Due to the steep slopes of this traditional small German estate of just 27 acres, vineyards are still tended and picked by hand. This is a typical Kabinett wine, light and semi-dry with an enticing mix of mineral and citrus flavors.
-  215 Domaine Pichot, **Vouvray** "Le Peu de la Moriette," Loire, France 2008 *Wine Spectator 90 pts* 32
Create from Chenin Blanc grapes, this semi-dry wine is light bodied with quince, fig, and lime notes backed by an easy, floral finish.
- 217 Marcel Deiss, **Pinot Gris**, "Bebenheim," Alsace, France, 2005 *Wine Advocate 90 pts* 56
Deiss constantly strives to transmit the character of the land to his exceptional wines. From a high-elevation, west-facing site, this wine is rich with considerable sweetness offering plum, peach, honey and spices.
- 225 Alexander Valley Vineyard, **Gewurztraminer**, Mendocino, CA, 2008 21
The light sweetness of this wine is offset by crisp, bright fruit.
- 230 G & M Machmer, **Gewürztraminer Spätlese**, Rheinhessen, Germany, 2007 40
A very small production of a typical German Gewürztraminer, with great balance between spice and sweetness.
- 235 Marqués de Cáceres, **Satinela**, Rioja, Spain 2008 22
This medium sweet wine shows honeyed flavors balanced with good acidity.

THE WORLD OF CHARDONNAY

Different climates and soil types create an amazing diversity of wines from this most noble of grapes.

- 400 Joseph Drouhin, **Chablis**, France, 2007 44
From the Northern region of Burgundy, this light bodied wine offers peach and floral notes and characteristic minerality imparted from the limestone soils.
- 410 A to Z Wineworks, **Chardonnay** Unoaked, Dundee, OR 2007 33
A staff favorite, this unoaked wine is light and refreshing with apple, pear and cream aromas and flavors.

- 415 Etienne Sauzet, **Puligny-Montrachet**, France, 2007 *Wine Advocate* 89 pts 98
Grown in the Cote d'Or and crafted by acclaimed winemaker Gerard Boudet, this wine is textbook Puligny - elegant, silky in texture offering lemon, toast, and hazlenut notes.
-  420 Chateau Montelena, **Chardonnay**, Napa, CA, 2006 *Wine Spectator* 88 pts 75
Established in 1882 and winner of the famous Judgement of Paris wine competition, this wine is made with a crisp, clean, refreshing style that shows little evidence of oak.
- 425 Matrot, **Bourgogne Blanc**, Burgundy, France, 2007 39
A pure example of a Burgundy Chardonnay—light with refreshing minerality.
-  430 Argyle, **Chardonnay** Nuthouse, Reserve, Willamette Valley, OR, 2005 *Wine Spectator* 91 pts 59
A single vineyard wine made in small quantities on just 40 acres, this refined wine shows very light oak with a refreshing core of pear and apple fruits.
- 435 Veramonte, **Chardonnay**, Aconcagua, Chile, 2007 *Wine Spectator* 89 pts 25
A relatively bold wine from the Casablanca Valley, featuring characteristic tropical flavors backed by a toasty but well-integrated finish.
- 440 Kistler, **Chardonnay** Dutton Ranch, Russian River Valley, CA, 2006 *Wine Spectator* 92 pts 105
This single vineyard wine from undoubtedly one of California's premier Chardonnay wineries serves up a complex mix of flavors. Full bodied ending with a lingering citrus and mineral edge.
- 445 Hess, **Chardonnay**, Monterey, California, 2008 25
A full-bodied, food-friendly wine with tropical flavors and creamy texture.
-  450 Glen Carlou, **Chardonnay**, Paarl, South Africa, 2007 *Wine Spectator* 89 pts 35
A ripe full-bodied, toasty style, with fig, brioche and pear notes backed by a buttery finish with hints of oak.
- 455 Chalk Hill, **Chardonnay**, Russian River Valley, Sonoma, CA, 2006 *Wine Spectator* 89 pts 82
Aged in French oak, this wine is well focused and balanced. A bold, rich, full-bodied style with layers of toasty oak, caramel, and fig.

LIGHT-MEDIUM BODIED REDS, FINE TANNINS *Delicate, fruit driven, refreshing acidity*

- 600 Louis Tete, **Beaujolais Villages**, Burgundy, France, 2008 29
Made from the Gamay grape, this is the lightest bodied red wine low in tannins with bright fresh fruit.
- 605 Erath, **Pinot Noir**, Willamette Valley, OR, 2007 *Wine Spectator* 88 pts 38
Light and crisp, with currant and floral aromas and flavors, this versatile wine is a classic Oregon Pinot-light, delicate and fruit-forward.
-  610 Argyle, **Pinot Noir**, Willamette Valley, WA, 2007 *Wine Spectator* 89 pts 56
This hand crafted wine is light and fragrant with a fruit driven style offering currant, spice, and coffee flavors with sweet Pinot fruit on the finish.
- 615 Hooked!, **Pinot Noir**, Baden, Germany, 2008 34
It is a great kept secret that Germany produces many outstanding Pinots. This wine is very fresh, with delicate berry flavors with a lingering finish.
- 630 Flowers Winery, **Pinot Noir**, Sonoma Coast, CA, 2007 83
A cool climate wine with crisp acidity and juicy flavors of strawberry, raspberry and black fruits. The mid palate is intense with fruit flavors and a lingering finish.

- 635 Sequana, **Pinot Noir**, Sarmento Vineyard, Santa Lucia Highlands, CA, 2007 *Wine Spectator 92 pts* 64
This single vineyard wine is deliciously complex and fruit forward with a range of flavors built around loamy currant, blackberry, plum and sassafras.
- 640 Lucien Le Moine, **Nuits-St. Georges Premier Cru** “Les Vaucrains,” Burgundy, France, 2006 *Wine Spectator 93 pts* 165
A wonderful example of burgundy Pinot Noir created by acclaimed winemaker Lucien Le Moine. Complex aromas and flavors are balanced with integrated acidity, fine tannins and a lingering finish
- 645 Tenuta Caparzo, **Brunello di Montalcino DOCG**, Tuscany, Italy, 2005 *Wine Spectator 92 pts* 69
Made from Sangiovese grapes, this elegant wine has ripe fruit flavors and aromas accented by spice with great balance and a complex finish.

MEDIUM BODIED REDS, SUBTLE TANNINS

Richly textured, fruit forward, smooth

- 700 Cono Sur, **Merlot**, Chile, 2008 24
Fresh and pure with jammy fruit flavors accented by modest vanilla on the round, easy finish.
- 705 Campo Viejo, **Rioja Reserva**, Spain, 2005 32
Spanish Reserva wines are aged in oak barrel for at least a year and up to two years in the bottle prior to their release. Made from Tempranillo grapes, this is a balanced, smooth, elegant wine with flavors of cherry, black plum and ripe blackberry.
- 710 Marqués de Cáceres, **Rioja Reserva**, Spain, 2002 52
Extended aging leads to an elegant, smooth wine with toasted notes and flavors of roasted coffee, chocolate and sweet spice.
- 715 Chateau Ste. Michelle, **Merlot** Canoe Ridge Vineyards, Columbia Valley, WA, 2005 42
Nestled on the south face of the ridge named by Lewis and Clark as they traveled down the Columbia River, this production has notes of berry and spice with subtle tannins.
- 720 Rocca dei Mori, **Copertino DOC**, Apulia, Italy, 2006 35
This wine is crafted using Negra Amaro and Montepuliciano grapes in the Apulia region in Southeast Italy. It has a deep ruby color, velvety fruit, and noticeable tannins that are balanced nicely with acidity creating a long, complex finish.
- 725 Duckhorn, **Merlot**, Napa, CA, 2006 *Wine Enthusiast 92 pts* 81
Classic Napa fruit, true to its varietal character, crafted into a prototype Merlot. This wine offers rich texture, ripe tannins and seamlessly integrated French oak. flavors.


MEDIUM-FULL BODIED REDS, NOTICEABLE TANNINS

Rich, bold, fruit-forward jammy flavors


- 800 Nine Stones, **Shiraz** “Hilltops,” Barossa, Australia, 2008 *Wine Spectator 90 pts* 30
This traditional fruit-driven wine shows blackberry and cardamon flavors that linger on a long finish.
- 805 Columbia Crest, **Shiraz** Grand Estate, Columbia Valley, WA, 2006 *Wine Spectator 89 pts* 26
Smooth with a mouthful of plum, blackberry, and spice flavors.

-  810 Yalumba, **Cabernet-Shiraz** “The Scribbler”, Barossa, Australia, 2007 *Wine Spectator 90 pts* 36
Australia’s oldest family owned winery, Yalumba is recognized for its environmental performance whilst producing many of Australia’s top wines. This lively wine offers layers of cherry, raspberry and mint flavors with a nice finish and fine tannins.
- 815 Peter Lehmann, **Cabernet-Shiraz** “Clancy’s,” Barossa, Australia, 2005 *Wine Spectator 88 pts* 34
The Australian tradition of mixing Shiraz and Cabernet is made softer with the additional blending of Merlot.
- 820 Klinker Brick, **Zinfandel** Old Vine, Lodi, CA 2007 37
Big and ripe with lingering sweetness, berry aromas and supple, spicy cherry and blackberry flavors.
-  825 Artezin, **Zinfandel**, Dry Creek Valley, CA 2006 *Wine Spectator 90 pts* 49
More complex than Klinker Brick, entry on the palate is a burst of berries, followed by spices and ripe fruit sweetness. The mid-palate is smooth and round with elegant tannins and a lush finish.

FULL-BODIED, DRY REDS
Bold, Rich, Elegant

- 829 Marchesi di Gresy, **Nebbiolo DOC Langhe** “Martinenga,” Piemonte, Italy, 2008 45
Produced from grapes grown in the same vineyard as the famed Barbaresco, this wine has all the character and elegance of a great Nebbiolo with an intense perfume of fine flowers and mature berries. Fresh and pleasant on the palate with typical tannic backbone balanced by characteristic Italian acidity.
- 830 Villa Mt. Eden, **Cabernet Sauvignon** Grand Reserve, Napa, CA 2005 *Wine Spectator 88 pts* 29
Supple and elegant, this wine is a touch earthy and savory, with spicy black cherry and wild berry fruit that’s delicate and easy drinking.
- 835 Hess, **Cabernet Sauvignon**, Napa, CA, 2007 32
Notably harmonious, supple and graceful, with ripe, fleshy plum, black cherry and raspberry fruit delivered in a full-bodied, easy drinking style.
- 840 Joseph Phelps, **Cabernet Sauvignon**, Napa, CA, 2005 *Wine Spectator 90 pts* 87
This dark-ruby colored wine resembles a classic Bordeaux both in aromatics and flavor. Smooth textured with subtle layers of currant, spice, herb, anise and light cedary oak, ending with a mix of ripe fruit and fine-grained tannin.
- 845 D’Arenberg, **Cabernet Sauvignon** “High Trellis,” McLaren Valley, Australia, 2006 *Wine Enthusiast 90 pts* 38
The palate flaunts ripe black currant and mulberry fruit with edgy, ripe tannins balanced with oak.
-  850 Obsidian, **Cabernet Sauvignon**, Red Hills, CA, 2006 *Wine Advocate 89 pts* 54
Covered with black, glassy Obsidian rock, the vineyard is planted primarily with Bordeaux clones. The wine is rich and densely structured. Recent tastings have voted this a favorite!
- 855 Chateau Montelena, **Cabernet Sauvignon**, Napa, CA, 2005 *Int'l Wine Cellar 93 pts* 145
This famed vineyard originally founded in 1882 is the subject of the recently released movie *Bottle Shock* depicting the story of the now infamous Judgement of Paris wine competition that put California winemakers firmly on the map. Deep ruby color and complex aromas lead to an impressively structured wine that is balanced and elegant—reminiscent of Bordeaux.

860 Arido, **Malbec**, Mendoza, Argentina, 2008 *Wine Spectator* 88 pts 24
 Unoaked, lighter and less concentrated than Colomé, this wine is ripe and focused, with solid raspberry fruit laced with sweet spice, toast and fruit notes.


 865 Bodega Colomé, **Malbec** Estate, Calchaqui Valley, Argentina, 2007 *Wine Spectator* 92 pts 49
 Part of the Hess Family Collection, many of the vines on this vineyard are over 100 years old. Dark, intense color with complex aromas of cherries, blackberries, white pepper and violets. The flavors are elegant and concentrated with a round finish.


ELEGANT RED BLENDS *Smooth, complex, delicious*


900 Perrin et Fils, **Côte du Rhône Réserve**, Rhone, France 2007 *Wine Advocate* 88 pts 26
 The foundation of this wine is Grenache, the traditional Southern Rhone grape. Grown on a steep slope, this blend is light, fresh and versatile with red berry fruits and fine tannins.

903 Chateau Devise d'Ardilley, **Haut-Médoc**, Bordeaux, France, 2006 41
 A spectacular vintage from this Cru Bourgeois vineyard with Cabernet as it's foundation. This is rich and round with noticeable tannins.

905 Larose de Gruaud, **St. Julien**, Bordeaux, France 2006 68
 This left bank winery is comprised of a selection of younger vines from the prestigious Chateau Gruaud Larose, a classified 2nd Growth. With Cabernet Sauvignon as its foundation, this wine has mineral and blackberry character.

 910 Chateau Coutet, **Saint-Émilion** Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France, 2005 *Wine Spectator* 90 pts 72
 This winery is located alongside the right bank of the Gironde River. With Merlot as its foundation, this wine is full bodied, with boysenberry and dark chocolate flavors and finishes with silky, round tannins.

 912 Enrico Santini, **Bolgheri DOC** "Poggio al Moro", Tuscany, Italy, 2007 *Wine Spectator* 91 pts 59
 A characteristic bold Tuscan wine. Full-bodied and generous with well-integrated tannins and dark fruit flavors.
Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Sangiovese, and Syrah

 915 Mas Belles Eaux, **Syrah-Grenache** "Les Couteaux," Languedoc, France, 2005 *Wine Spectator* 91 pts 39
 A refined, elegant red from the South of France with an enticing aroma of pepper and sage. Flavors of raspberry, kirsch, red cherry and hints of garrigue and a pure, mineral finish.

925 Boekenhoutskloof, **Syrah-Mourvèdre-Viognier** "Wolftrap," Western Cape, South Africa, 2008 22
 Good concentration with plum, violet and vanilla notes and a soft finish

930 Col Solare, **Meritage**, Columbia Valley, WA, 2005 *Wine Advocate* 94 pts 109
 This winery is a collaboration between Chateau Ste. Michelle and famed Italian winemaker Marchese Antinori. A classic Cabernet Bordeaux style blend, it is full-bodied supple, complex with spicy, smoky, blackberry, cherry and plum flavors, and a long, expressive finish.

935 Domaine Paul Autard, **Châteauneuf-du-Pape**, Cuvee La Cote Ronde, Rhone, France, 2006 *Wine Spectator* 94 pts 98
 Very expressive with gorgeous aromatics and flavors, this wine has a racy, fruit packed core of raspberry ganache, fig and boysenberry buttressed by dark cocoa, espresso, roasted chestnut and graphite notes. Long and intense through the finish, with fruit and minerality intertwined for the long haul.
